With the help of expert fresh food formulator Steve Brown, I developed Meal Mix for Adult Dogs because I know that as a dedicated pet parent passionate about your animal companion's health, you want to provide your canine family member with high-quality, fresh, real food. Since this can be easier said than done, Meal Mix for Dogs gives you the tools you need to effortlessly create high-quality, nutritionally optimal homemade meals for your adult dog(s).

Many homemade and prey-model diets and some commercially available raw, freeze dried, and gently cooked diets are nutritionally incomplete (find out by asking the company to email you their complete nutritional analysis, as compared to accepted nutrient standards). This can cause your pet to become deficient in the correct amounts of important minerals and vitamins, antioxidants, or the right fatty acid balance for skeletal, organ and immune health.

A considerable amount of research has gone into determining what nutrients dogs need to survive, and there is ample evidence showing what happens when they are deprived of the full range of critical nutrients necessary for cell growth, repair, and maintenance. In fact, many integrative veterinarians believe many of the chronic degenerative diseases plaguing pets today are rooted in long standing micronutrient deficiencies.

Fresh, homemade meat and veggie diets provide the protein, fat, and fiber your pup needs, but research shows the vast majority of homemade diets are missing important micronutrients unless the recipe you're following has been formulated with specific key ingredients, like Brazil nuts to meet selenium requirements, and oysters for zinc.

Meal Mix for Dogs takes care of vitamin and mineral deficiencies that may exist. If you opt not to use supplements, you must add in these extra whole food sources of these nutrients, which requires additional money, sourcing creativity, and math.

If you're preparing a homemade diet for your pet, I can't emphasize enough the importance of ensuring it's nutritionally balanced. Making your dog's food from scratch requires you to ensure you're meeting macro and micronutrient requirements. This can be so intimidating that many pet parents never diversify their dog's bowl, which research says is one of the poorest decisions for long-term health.

Sample Recipes Using Meal Mix for Dogs

With Meal Mix for Dogs and the recipe formulator, you're in complete control of every nutritious, delicious morsel that goes into your dog's body. The following are previews of a few of the meals generated by the formulator (note: these are not complete recipes, they're the ingredients you'll be adding to Meal Mix to create a complete and balanced meal).

Bison With Portabella Mushroom and Sweet Potato

Nutritional value: 29 kCal/oz // Feeding amount: 249 kCal/day lbs

Ingredients

- 🐾 12 oz Bison meat, grass fed or wild
- 🐾 4 oz Portabella mushroom
- 🐾 4 oz Sweet potato (boiled, skin included)
- 🐾 .5 tsp Sunflower, safflower, hemp seed or walnut oil
- 🐾 2 g Marine-based omega-3 oil
- 🐾 1 pkt Meal Mix for Dogs

Feed 9 oz per day, split into as many meals as desired. Supplements such as probiotics, digestive enzymes, and organ support products may be added.

Chicken, Skin-on, Dark Meat With Carrot and Broccoli

Nutritional value: 38 kCal/oz // Feeding amount: 249 kCal/day lbs

Ingredients

- 🐾 12 oz Chicken, dark meat (skin included)
- 🐾 3 oz Carrots
- 🐾 3 oz Broccoli
- 🐾 2 g Marine-based omega-3 oil
- 🐾 1 pkt Meal Mix for Dogs

This meal is nutritionally balanced with vitamins and minerals, adding additional vitamin supplements is not recommended.

Lean Ground Beef With Spinach and Summer or Zucchini Squash

Nutritional value: 37 kCal/oz // Feeding amount: 249 kCal/day lbs

Ingredients

- 🐾 12 oz Ground beef, 85% lean
- 🐾 4 oz Spinach
- 🐾 4 oz Squash, summer or zucchini
- 🐾 1 tsp Sunflower, safflower, hemp seed or walnut oil
- 🐾 2 g Marine-based omega-3 oil
- 🐾 1 pkt Meal Mix for Dogs

Feeding directions are based on your dog's weight and activity level, adjust amount to feed according to your veterinarian's advice.

Turkey, Dark Meat With Cucumber and Green Peas

Nutritional value: 21 kCal/oz // Feeding amount: 249 kCal/day lbs

Ingredients

- 🐾 16 oz Turkey, dark meat (skinless)
- 🐾 4 oz Cucumber
- 🐾 4 oz Green peas (with pod)
- 🐾 2 oz Cottage cheese, 2% fat
- 🐾 2 g Marine-based omega-3 oil
- 🐾 1 pkt Meal Mix for Dogs

Additional portions can be stored in the refrigerator for up to three days, or freezer for up to two weeks. Frozen portions can be thawed overnight by transferring to the refrigerator.

Wild Duck With Asparagus and White Rice

Nutritional value: 40 kCal/oz // Feeding amount: 249 kCal/day lbs

Ingredients

- 🐾 12 oz Wild duck (skin included)
- 🐾 4 oz Asparagus
- 🐾 4 oz White rice, cooked
- 🐾 2 g Marine-based omega-3 oil
- 🐾 1 pkt Meal Mix for Dogs

Weighing instructions: All ingredients (raw or cooked) should be weighed right before mixing together.

Meal Mix is designed to be part of a total meal plan with recipes and ideas for feeding your dog a variety of healthy, balanced homemade meals.
